The Company is also committed to continual improvement of occupational health & safety management and performance.

This policy is reviewed annually by the Board of Directors. In reviewing this Policy, the comments of our employees are taken into account. The Policy is communicated to all staff and those working on behalf of Northumbrian Roads Ltd. It is available to the public via the website.
